Bhagavad Geeta & Mahabharata Competition 2025 – Candidate Instructions for Verse Selection and Recitation

For Ages 5–7

Selected Verses (Chapter 12, Verses 13–17):

1. Verse 12.13

adveshṭā sarva-bhūtānām maitraḥ karuṇa eva cha nirmamo nirahankāraḥ sama-duḥkha-sukhaḥ kṣhamī

2. Verse 12.14

santuṣhṭaḥ satataṁ yogī yatātmā dṛiḍha-niśhchayaḥ mayy arpita-mano-buddhir yo mad-bhaktaḥ sa me priyaḥ

3. Verse 12.15

yasmān nodvijate loko lokān nodvijate cha yaḥ harṣhāmarṣha-bhayodvegair mukto yaḥ sa cha me priyaḥ

4. Verse 12.16

anapekṣhaḥ śhuchir dakṣha udāsīno gata-vyathaḥ sarvārambha-parityāgī yo mad-bhaktaḥ sa me priyaḥ

5. Verse 12.17

Recitation Rules:

- **Recitation Only:** Candidates are required to recite the above five verses exactly as provided.
- No Memorization or Speech Required.
- *Note:* Extra memorization beyond the stated requirement will not be awarded extra points.

For Ages 8-10

Selected Verses (Chapter 3, Verses 10–14):

1. Verse 3.10

saha-yajñāḥ prajāḥ sṛiṣhṭvā purovācha prajāpatiḥ anena prasaviṣhyadhvam eṣha vo 'stviṣhṭa-kāma-dhuk

2. Verse 3.11

devān bhāvayatānena te devā bhāvayantu vaḥ parasparam bhāvayantaḥ śhreyaḥ param avāpsyatha

3. Verse 3.12

iṣhṭān bhogān hi vo devā dāsyante yajña-bhāvitāḥ tair dattān apradāyaibhyo yo bhuṅkte stena eva saḥ

4. Verse 3.13

yajña-śhiṣhṭāśhinaḥ santo muchyante sarva-kilbiṣhaiḥ bhuñjate te tvaghaṁ pāpā ye pachantyātma-kāraṇāt

5. Verse 3.14

annād bhavanti bhūtāni parjanyād anna-sambhavaḥ yajñād bhavati parjanyo yajñah karma-samudbhavah

Recitation Rules:

- **Recitation:** All five verses must be recited clearly.
- **Speech Requirement:** A short speech is required on **one designated verse**. (Verse to be selected by candidate). (Time Limit: 5 minutes)
- No additional memorization beyond these requirements. No verses or speech need to be memorised.

Speech on One Designated Verse:

- **Understanding**: Ability to explain the meaning of the selected verse.
- **Clarity and Articulation**: How clearly and confidently the candidate expresses the meaning of the verse.
- **Time Limit**: The speech should not exceed 5 minutes. Exceeded time will not be considered.

For Ages 11–13

Selected Verses (Chapter 2, Verses 31–37):

1. Verse 2.31

swa-dharmam api chāvekṣhya na vikampitum arhasi dharmyāddhi yuddhāch chhreyo 'nyat kṣhatriyasya na vidyate

2. Verse 2.32

yadṛichchhayā chopapannam swarga-dvāram apāvṛitam sukhinaḥ kṣhatriyāḥ pārtha labhante yuddham īdṛiśham

3. Verse 2.33

atha chet tvam imam dharmyam sangrāmam na karishyasi tataḥ sva-dharmam kīrtim cha hitvā pāpam avāpsyasi

4. Verse 2.34

akīrtim chāpi bhūtāni kathayiṣhyanti te 'vyayām sambhāvitasya chākīrtir maranād atirichyate

Recitation Rules:

- **Recitation:** All seven verses must be recited.
- Memorization: Verses 2.36 and 2.37 must be memorized exactly as provided.
- **Speech Requirement:** A short speech is required on **one selected verse** (Verse to be selected by candidate). (Time Limit: 5 minutes)

• *Note:* Additional memorization beyond these requirements will not yield extra points.

Speech on One Selected Verse:

- **Interpretation**: Depth of understanding and explanation of the selected verse.
- **Delivery and Engagement**: Confidence, voice modulation, and the ability to engage the audience.
- **Relevance and Structure**: How well the candidate organizes their thoughts and stays on topic.
- **Time Limit**: 5 minutes. Exceeded time will not be considered.

For Ages 14–17

Selected Verses (Chapter 6, Verses 5–11):

1. Verse 6.5

2. **Verse 6.6**

jitātmanaḥ praśhāntasya paramātmā samāhitaḥ śhītoṣhṇa-sukha-duḥkheṣhu tathā mānāpamānayoh

Recitation Rules:

- **Recitation:** All seven verses must be recited.
- **Memorization:** All verses are required to be memorized exactly as provided.
- **Speech Requirement:** A short speech is required for **each verse**, expressing personal interpretation and understanding. (Time Limit: 8 minutes)

Speech on Each Verse:

- **Personal Interpretation**: Candidates must provide their own understanding of each verse and its relevance.
- **Expression and Impact**: How effectively the candidate communicates the deeper meaning and engages the listeners.
- **Comprehension**: Ability to explain the connection between the verses and convey overall understanding.
- **Time Limit**: 8 minutes. Exceeded time will not be considered.
- *Note:* Unnecessary memorization beyond these requirements will not award extra points.

For Ages 18–30

Selected Verses (Chapter 18, Verses 63–69):

1. Verse 18.63

iti te jñānam ākhyātam guhyād guhyataram mayā vimṛiśhyaitad aśheṣheṇa yathechchhasi tathā kuru

2. Verse 18.64

sarva-guhyatamam bhūyaḥ śhṛiṇu me paramam vachaḥ iṣhṭo 'si me dṛiḍham iti tato vakṣhyāmi te hitam

3. Verse 18.65

man-manā bhava mad-bhakto mad-yājī māṁ namaskuru mām evaiṣhyasi satyaṁ te pratijāne priyo 'si me

4. Verse 18.66

sarva-dharmān parityajya mām ekam śharaṇam vraja aham tvām sarva-pāpebhyo mokṣhayiṣhyāmi mā śhuchaḥ

5. Verse 18.67

Recitation Rules:

- **Recitation:** All seven verses must be recited accurately.
- **Memorization:** Complete memorization of each verse is required.
- **Speech Requirement:** A short speech is required for **each verse**, articulating personal insight into its meaning. (Time Limit: 10 minutes)

Speech on Each Verse:

- **Insight and Analysis**: In-depth personal insight into the meaning of each verse, demonstrating a thorough understanding.
- Clarity and Persuasiveness: Clarity in articulation and ability to persuade the audience of their interpretation.
- **Comprehensiveness**: Coverage of all verses in a well-structured manner without unnecessary content.
- **Time Limit**: 10 minutes. Exceeded time will not be considered.
- *Note:* Extra memorization beyond these requirements will not be awarded additional points.

General Guidelines for All Candidates:

- Ensure clear pronunciation and proper pacing during recitation.
- Stick to the prescribed number of verses and requirements—extra content or memorization beyond what is specified will not garner extra marks.
- Practice both recitation and speech delivery to convey the deeper meaning of each verse.
- Time limits are to be strictly adhered, at the last minute mark, the judge will inform you accordingly.
